



**The MG Car Club Limited -
Midland Centre
Three Counties Road Run
14/15 August 2021**



REGULATIONS

1. The MG Car Club Limited - Midland Centre will promote a non-competitive Touring Assembly with a 55 mile route from the Triumph & MG Show at the Three Counties Showground at Malvern on Saturday 14 and Sunday 15 August 2021.
2. The event is open to members of the MG Car Club, MG Owners Club, TR Register and Triumph Sports Six Club. As this is a non-competitive event, MSA competition licences are not required.
3. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the promoting club may issue for the event.
4. MSA Exemption Certificate Permit Number *TBA*.
5. The tour will be approximately 55 miles in length starting and finishing at the Three Counties Showground, Malvern, OS map reference 150 / 786428).
6. All drivers must have a current valid driving licence for driving in the UK.
All cars must be road legal and insured as required under the Road Traffic Act.
Covid Regulations may require social distancing and the wearing of face coverings.
7. Signing-on will be by e-mail and Documentation will be at the MGCC Midland Centre Gazebo at the Showground from 09.30 until 11.30, where you will be provided with your Rally Plate (with plastic ties to fix it to the front of your car, and tulip Road Book (no complex navigation skills are necessary), The tour will start with the cars departing between 10.00 am and 12.00 noon on both Saturday and Sunday and 16.00 to 17.00 on Saturday.
8. The route will be given in an easy to follow Road Book with Tulip Diagrams, which will be issued to entrants at the Documentation. Maps are not necessary to complete the route, but Ordnance Survey 'Landranger' maps 1:50,000 scale, map numbers 149, 150 and 162 have been used to determine the route.
9. Entries open on the publication of these Regulations, and close finally at 5.00 pm on 11 August 2021. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of £15.00 per car.
10. The minimum number of entrants for the event is 10, and the maximum is 30 for each of the three runs. Should the minimum number not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event. Late entries on the day may be possible if the maximum has not been reached and subject to Covid Regulations.

11. Drivers Briefing will be made by email on 11 August and you must return your Signing-on e-mail within 24 hours of receipt.
12. Entry to the Show for car or passengers is not included in the Road Run Entry Fee.
13. Should an entrant wish to withdraw after the closing date, then the entry fee will be returned less an admin fee of £5.00.
14. Change of car is permitted provided you notify the Organisers at Documentation, on the day of the event.
15. The timetable of the event will be as follows:
 - Documentation will start from approximately 09.30 until 11.30.
 - The first car to leave the start will be at 10.00.
 - Arrival time at the finish is at your discretion (12.00pm – 2.00pm).
16. No catering is provided on the event, but there are many venues where you can stop if you so wish, some of which will be noted in the Road Book, or you can take your own picnic. There are restaurant facilities at the Showground (which might be busy) and we anticipate your return there between 12.00 and 2.00 pm depending if you stop for lunch en route.
